

Shishkaball Ball-Drop Game- This is basically a life size version of KerPlunk. It looks really fun if you are up for a serious DIY project.

Rules:

Push sticks all the way through the center tube piece. Add balls (or whatever you choose to play with) onto the top section of the tube once all the sticks are in place. Number off everybody playing, and open the side of the tube base to match up with your number on your turn. On your turn, pull a stick out of the tube. The goal of the game, like KerPlunk, is to not let any balls drop. The fewer the balls you have in your numbered compartment (a section at the bottom of the tube) the closer you are to winning. The player with the least amount of balls in their compartment wins.
