Please note that these tests only give a snapshot of how well your child(ren) performed on a test on a certain day. It does not say anything about how smart they are or how much they know. Many students have test anxiety and some are just not good test takers. For that reason, I use multiple measures in the classroom to assess students. Even so I will use the test results to improve our instruction. I do want to let you all know that the students performed particularly well in math, science, and social studies. Areas where we will be working to improve will be grammar and mechanics.

I must say another thank you to Karine as she spent a great deal of last weekend working on compiling this data. It is very tedious work to go through all the necessary charts and tables and she did a very careful and precise job. I also want to thank Gwen for working so many hours on our library. We are missing many books, so please have your children check their rooms to see if they might have one of our books they have forgotten.

This week the students will have both P.O.W.s and graded work folders going home. Please be sure they are returned by Friday. Students should also have their first draft of their research paper done by February 22 for peer editing. We will be doing this in groups of three to get better participation by all students and ensure that it is a learning experience as well.

In science, this week we will finish our unit on the digestive system. We will also spend some time on food labels from the CATCH program.

In the 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> math class, we will be finishing our chapter on percentages by working on markup and discount and simple interest.

In social studies, we continue our study of Manifest Destiny and the westward movement. Next week, we will move into a study of the Civil War.
