Our work with the growth mindset from the Responsive Classroom has started to have a positive effect on our students. It can be seen in attitudes as well as scores in math and ELA. We have also been concentrating on team building with our morning meetings and morning message and I feel like that has brought some of our kids more out of themselves so they are interacting more with the whole group.

The students have been doing a great job of sending notes to the younger children who they are secret buddies for. They had a break from writing notes or cards to them this week since it was a short week.

We started *A Wrinkle in Time* this week and will move forward with that tomorrow. The students have all started drafting their science fiction stories. These are due on Friday, October

27. They must be in final copy format having been peer edited and typed. The stories must be a minimum of three typed pages. Students have been working on this in class. They also need to spend time at home working on this as well as their reading for the allotted time each night.

We have finished our unit on space science and will be moving into a study of minerals and rocks starting next week. We are currently studying civilizations in Mesopotamia but will be moving on to ancient Egypt by the end of next week. This will involve a lot of projects and hands-on work

In math we are working on various concepts depending on the students and where they are in their learning. Fifth grade math students are working on multiplying whole numbers and decimals and patterns involved with this. Sixth grade math is working on different ways to display and interpret data. Seventh grade math is working on fractions and decimals. Our algebra student will be starting to work on inequalities on Monday.

Our Oktoberfest and Halloween party are coming up on Tuesday, October 31. Students will be participating in multiage activities from 1:30 until 2:30. From 2:30 to 3:00 they will be having their own class party and for kids this age that means food and music. I am going to ask them to plan what they need and then send out requests for donations. From 3:00-3:30 they will be cleaning up and then enjoying some free play outside.
