Happy Thursday! We had a great time this week learning about different jungle animals. The students continued to work on number order - which they are quickly becoming experts at - creating simple patterns, and practicing letter sounds.

Next week we will be learning the letters Kk and Ll and focusing on kindness and love. Three-year olds will work on number matching and will begin reviewing numbers 1-10. They will continue practicing name writing and fine motor control. Four-year olds will continue with simple addition problems and letter sounds. Kindergarten will continue their unit on subtraction concepts and retelling stories.
