Three-year olds worked on number matching, patterns, and name writing. Four-year olds worked on simple addition, lowercase letter recognition, and writing in their journals. Kindergarten worked on retelling stories, writing in their journals, and continued with subtraction.

Next week we will be learning the letter Nn and reading different nursery rhymes. We are hoping to be completely grounded in the concepts we've been working on before winter break. When we come back we will be moving on to shape recognition and drawing, color recognition, and creating more complex patterns.
