What a wonderful week we have had learning about robots! Special thanks to Adam Haddick for bringing in a robot to share with the class, it was definitely the highlight of the week! We also designed our own robots and wrote about what we would do if we had a robot of our own - there were some pretty creative ideas!

Next week we will be learning the letter Ss and talking about space! We have a lot of hands on activities planned, including ending the week with a rocket race! In math the three year olds are working on shapes (sorting, tracing, drawing), four year olds are working on number order and simple addition, and kindergarten began a new unit on different addition strategies such as counting on and adding in any order. In literacy the three year olds are continuing to work on letter recognition and name writing, four year olds are practicing letter sounds, specifically beginning sounds, and kindergarten is working on segmenting words and using our letter sound knowledge to write.
