## **Math**

Kindergarten: Chapter 5: Model and Draw addition sentences; Write addition sentences

Grade 1: We will continue practicing basic addition problems while moving forward in the chapters.

Chapter 4: Think addition to subtract; Use 10 to subtract

Grade 3: I would like to encourage families to practice multiplication flashcards. Memorizing multiplication will be your child's most useful tool as we move towards division. Start with ones and when they have mastered that level and the twos... and so on.
