## First Grade

Phonics: Digraphs ch, tch; Possessive 's
Grammer: Proper Nouns
Spelling Words: chin, chop, much, chip, rich, chick

## Second Grade

Phonics: Vowel Digraphs ai, ay
Grammer: Kinds of Sentences
Spelling Words: pay, wait, paint, train, pail, clay, tray, plain, stain, hay, gray, away

## Third Grade

Phonics: Homophones; Words ending in -er, -le
Grammer: More proper nouns
Spelling Words: hole, whole, its, it's, hear, here, won, one, our, hour, their, there, fur, fir
Students will need to know definitions of the spelling words. They will have to understand how to spell it based on the context of the sentence.
