Please practice addition facts at home to help them prepare for their minute tests(1st grade doubles and addends 0, 1, and 2. 2nd grade doubles and addends 0, 1,2,3,4, and 5). We have been practicing the facts at school using computer games. Students seem to like www.ABCya.com the best for math games.

Concepts this week in math:

 1_{st} grade – Addition Strategies (using doubles plus 1 and minus 1 and making 10 to find the sum)

2nd grade - Two Digit Subtraction (breaking apart ones and regrouping to find the difference)

Green Group

Writing- Descriptive writing

Grammar- Prepositions and Prepositional phrases

Reading- A Cupcake Party by David McPhail (fantasy)

Orange/Purple Group

Writing -Persuasive/Opinion writing

Grammar-Quotation Marks review

Reading- Martin Luther King Jr. by Alyse Sweeney

Purple Group

Choosing a book about Equal Rights and completing a writing assignment.

Students will work on book reports.

Spelling

Spelling list 1 – short u words and final clusters

Spelling list 2 -ee and ea words

Spelling list 3- Long e, ei, ea, and ee words

Reading Groups

Group 1 – short u sounds, final clusters, /m/ sounds (m and mb), high-frequency words, differentiating vowel sounds in the middle of words, and segmenting phonemics.

Group 2- long e sounds (vowel digraphs ee and ea), matching phonemes, diagraphs, high frequency words, fluency, and idioms
